PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the City Council of the City of Port Richey, Florida at its regular meeting to be held on Wednesday the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021 at 7:00 P.M., at City Hall, 6333 Ridge Rd., Port Richey, Florida will have its second and final reading of Ordinance No. 21-683, the title which reads:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PORT RICHEY MODEL ORDINANCE FOR FLORIDA FRIENDLY FERTILIZER USE ON URBAN LANDSCAPES; PROVIDING FOR A NEW ARTICLE TO CHAPTER 14 ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE IX FLORIDA FRIENDLY FERTILIZER USE ON URBAN LANDSCAPES, PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS, PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE AND INTENT; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR APPLICABILITY; PROVIDING FOR TIMING OF FERTILIZER APPLICATION; PROVIDING FOR FERTILIZER FREE ZONES; PROVIDING FOR LOW MAINTENANCE ZONES; PROVIDING FOR FERTILIZER CONTENT AND APPLICATION RATES; PROVIDING FOR APPLICATION PRACTICES; PROVIDING FOR MANAGEMENT OF GRASS CLIPPINGS AND VEGETATIVE MATTER; PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR TRAINING; PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF COMMERCIAL APPLICATORS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Any and all persons interested or concerned with the proposed ordinance may appear and will be heard with regard to the same.
