- ✚ Found a cellphone vendor option for the P.D. & F.D. that would reduce the cost of service substantially or to “0” cost. Working with Mr. Licari to evaluate the possibility of a citywide transition but at a minimum the P.D. & F.D.
- ✚ Continuing Policy & Procedure revisions and additions
- ✚ Continuing Full Property & Evidence inventory
- ✚ Continuing to monitor COVID-19 (Variant D) situation and vaccine distribution issues to determine potential impact and adjustments to our response
- ✚ Continuing to monitor intelligence regarding events, incidents, or persons of interest
- ✚ Scheduling Juvenile training session with SAO, PSO Diversion and DJJ Probation & Parole presenting. Awaiting a date that is acceptable for all parties (possibly Oct. or Nov.)
- ✚ Continued participation in the FDOT/IPTM Traffic Safety Initiative geared towards bicyclist and pedestrian safety within our jurisdiction by utilizing High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) and education. We are the only Pasco County agency participating for the 2nd consecutive iteration.
- ✚ Conducted a 2 -week Traffic Enforcement Ops Plan in the area of Ridge Rd. & Leo Kidd due to a complaint from the mobile home park.
- ✚ Initiated an Ops Plan for a residence regarding suspicious activity
- ✚ Continued work on some small revitalization projects for the agency (installed exterior lights for non-functioning police department signage)
- ✚ Working with HR to post the job opening for Officer and Dispatcher on various sites.
- ✚ Scheduled officer off-site training classes throughout the fiscal year (CIT classes at both Hernando and Pasco were cancelled due to COVID-19 concerns) they will advise when the next classes are scheduled.
- ✚ Still awaiting response from F.D. volunteers/Walmart regarding grant for (2) new bicycles
