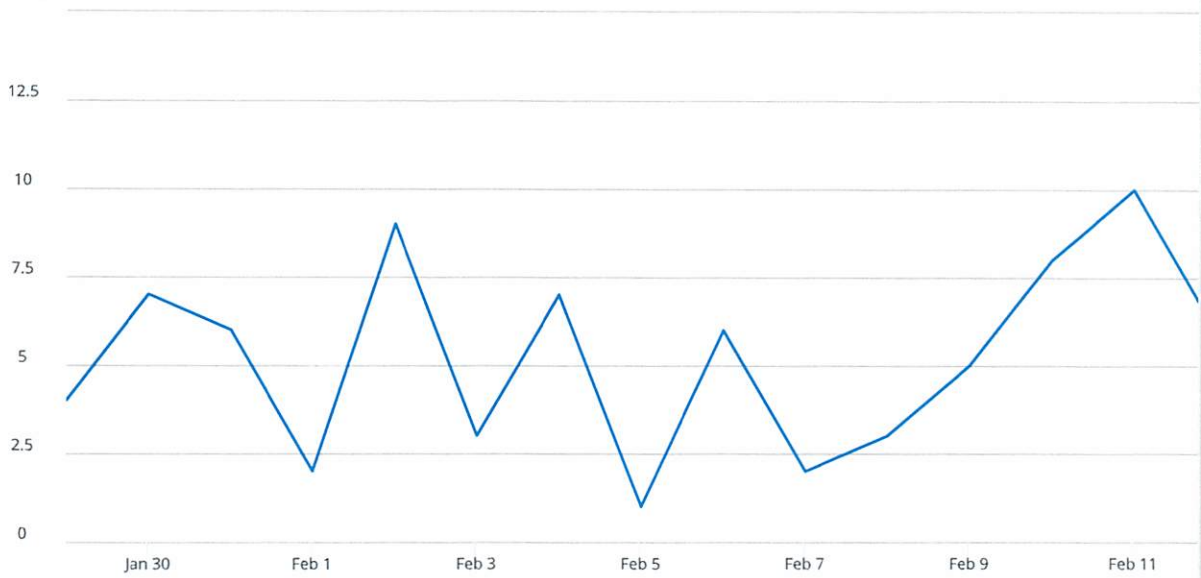

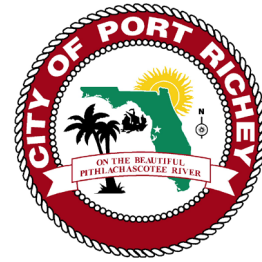

FEBRUARY 2022 PUBLIC WORKS & UTILITIES MONTHLY REPORT

Week of January 31, 2022 – February 04, 2022

PUBLIC WORKS

- Staff completed weekly maintenance at all City parks. (mowed, string trimmed, emptied trash, cleaned and re-stocked restrooms).
- Public Works crew mowed, string trimmed, edged, and blew off parking lot off City Hall.
- Pressure washed all curbing at the Grand Boulevard and U.S. Highway 19 island.
- Staff completed a landscaping project at the Grand Boulevard and U.S. Highway 19 island, i.e., replaced weed barrier, installed new plants, new mulch, and new rock.
