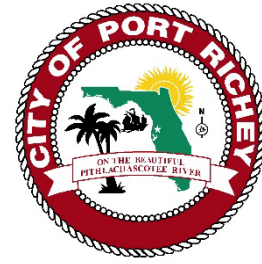

PUBLIC WORKS & UTILITIES MONTHLY REPORT

Week of April 4, 2022 – April 8, 2022

PUBLIC WORKS

- Staff completed weekly maintenance at all City parks. (mow, string trimmer, emptied trash, cleaned and re-stocked restrooms).
- Public Works crew mowed, string trimmer, edged and blew off the parking lot at City Hall.
- Public Works staff completed weekly lawn & landscaping at Public Works Complex.
- Crew string trimmed behind fence line at the City DMMA site.
- Staff performed monthly City brush pick up.
- Staff prepped the Limestone Dr. Pier for the engineering structural testing.
- Public Works Crew performed weekly maintenance on all landscaping and heavy equipment. (sharpened mower blades, string trimmers, fueled mowers and machinery, and organized facility yard).

UTILITIES

- Staff performed weekly maintenance on forty-four (44) City maintained lift stations.
- Crew members removed the following lift station pumps to remove flushed rags and debris;
 - Green Street – Pump one
 - Carolyn Drive – Pump one
- Utilities Crew cleaned and degreased the Limestone Dr. Pier lift station.
- The crew replaced pump two (2) at the Webber Ln. lift station.
- Staff completed various work orders for the Utility Billing office (meter field tests, inspection for possible leaks, and meter change-outs)
- Staff completed monthly manual meter readings for the Utility Billing office (380 service orders)
- The utility crew performed various work orders for the Utility Billing office (meter installs, meter status checks, and checks for leaks).
- The utility crew snaked/camera the sewer line at 7717 Deedra Circle due to a sewer backup.
- The utility staff performed water and sewer line locates for 811 sunshine located for contractors digging.
- Staff performed weekly maintenance at the facility yard (cleaned and detailed fleet vehicles, removed trash/debris, fueled equipment and organized parts).

WATER PLANT

- Technicians performed a daily walk-through and inspection of the Water Treatment Plant.
- Water Plant Operators performed a thorough backwash process on sand filters one(1) and two(2).
- Staff performed daily inspections at the remote well field.
- The Water Plant Operators prepared and mixed daily chemicals KMNO4 for water treatment.
- Water Treatment Plant Staff cleaned the CL17 monitors.
- Staff completed fire hydrant flushing on Washington Street and Salt Springs Road.
- Technicians repaired a leak at well #2.
- Water Plant Operators completed monthly water loss reporting.

Week of April 11, 2022 – April 15, 2022

PUBLIC WORKS

- Public Works Crew performed weekly maintenance on all City parks. (mow, string trimmer, cleaned and stocked restrooms, emptied all trash cans, and cleaned all playgrounds).
- Staff mowed grass & string trimmer, and performed yard maintenance on City Hall and the Police Departments Impound Lot.
- Public Works associates assisted the Utilities Department, Restoration & Protective Services with (MOT) Maintenance of traffic on Bay Boulevard, Richey Drive, and Wilkins Street (staff was onsite to direct traffic for five days due to an emergency repair).

UTILITIES

- Personnel performed weekly maintenance on forty-four (44) City maintained lift stations.
- Crew members removed the Famous Tate lift station pump #2 to remove flushed rags and debris;
- Utility associates replaced a broken three (3) HP grinder pump at the Webber Ln. lift station.
- Staff assisted Restoration & Protective Services with the emergency repair of the master maintenance hole at the Bay Boulevard lift station.
- The utility crew replaced a 4' section of the 8" force main with an 8" C900 pipe and installed a new 8" 90 mega lug into the repaired maintenance hole on Bay Blvd.
- Utilities Staff supported Restoration & Protective Services during the master maintenance hole repair on Bay Blvd. by shutting down lift stations on the west side of town. This task was completed while contractors were submerged in the maintenance hole, making necessary repairs.
- Staff actively assisted with the VACTOR truck extracting debris from the gravity sewer lines while repairs were performed on the master maintenance hole.

WATER PLANT

- Technicians performed a daily walk-through and inspection of the Water Treatment Plant.
- Staff back washed sand filters one (1) and two (2).
- Water Plant operators performed daily checks on the remote well field.
- Operators performed maintenance on the recovery basin and transferred iron bags.
- Technicians mixed daily chemicals KMNO4 for water treatment.
- Staff performed work on the recovery pump and valves.
- Crewmembers updated all computers and SCADA software for plant monitoring.
- Operators mowed, and string trimmed the water treatment plant.
- Technicians performed lab samples and meter calibration on testing equipment.

- Employees installed a new concrete slab on Island Dr. due to a 6" water main break under a driveway.
- Public Works staff installed a new concrete slab on Mallet Dr. due to a 2" water main break under a driveway.
- Staff delivered electronic surplus equipment to Pasco County's Hays Rd. facility for recycling.
- Crew members performed work at the maintenance facility yard (cleaning up the yard of debris, organizing equipment, back blading asphalt millings on the roadway)
- Employees performed maintenance on all landscaping equipment (sharpen mower blades, stringing trimmers, fueling equipment)

UTILITIES

- Utility staff performed weekly maintenance on forty-four (44) lift stations.
- Crew members pulled and de-ragged the lift station pump at Waterfront Park.
- Staff performed water and sewer main locates for 811 sunshine locates for contractors digging.
- Employees repaired a 10" water main due to contractors hitting the main.
- The utility crew replaced a 2" water-main valve leaking on Pasco Way and Cormel St.
- Staff repaired and 2" water-main break on Mallet Dr.
- Employees performed various work orders for the Utility Billing office (meter change-outs, check for possible leaks, meter status, and hydrant meter installs.
- Personnel performed maintenance at the facility yard (organizing trucks, organizing parts, greasing machinery, and cleaning trucks)

WATER PLANT

- Technicians performed a daily walk-through and inspection of the Water Treatment Plant.
- Staff back washed sand filters one (1) and two (2).
- Personnel performed daily checks on the remote well field.
- Water Plant staff updated the SCADA computers and files.
- Staff updated water loss reports on a spreadsheet file.
- Crew members replaced the hose and valve on the pump manifold for the KMNO4 pump.
- Staff mixed chemicals KMNO4 for water treatment.
